ON-SITE RV CAMPGROUND

Open early to mid April through mid October as weather allows. Reservations are highly recommended. In order to determine positive effects, a stay of 10 days is recommended, though not mandatory.

3 full Hookups

Includes sewer, water and electric with 15, 30 and 50 amps. Reserve in advance.

1-2 adults (inc. tax) \$24.84/night

10 Electric Only

Access to water, 15 amps, inside sanitary facilities, no dump.

1-2 adults (inc. tax) \$15.12/night

On-site Rental Unit

Ten night minimum stay. Two twin beds, fully furnished with linens, utensils, pots and pans, microwave, toaster, coffee pot. Shower, DISH tv, A/C and internet. Deck with two steps, pet with permission. Laundry facility accessible onsite.

1-2 people (inc. tax) \$59.40/night

Miners Cabin (on-site)

Similar to a KOA cabin, clean and comfortable, but rustic. One room studio. There is no running water or bathroom. Guests will use campground facilities in main office building. 2 showers and 3 bathrooms. Dish TV, WiFi, 3 beds, wood stove, some kitchenware, small refrigerator, coffee pot, BBQ, microwave. Linens and bedding supplied.

1-5 Nights: \$86.40 (tax included) per night.

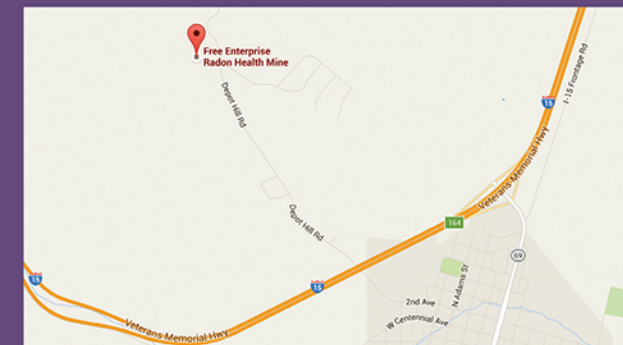

HOW TO GET HERE

Boulder is midway between Butte and Helena at exit 164 on Interstate 15 (I-15). Both cities have airports.

Rent a car or take a taxi to Boulder. For those without a car, make advance arrangements with your motel for their shuttle service options to/from Boulder.

Amtrak stops in Shelby and may require an overnight stay. Round trip shuttle service to Boulder is offered for a fee. Fare is subject to gasoline prices. Please call us for transportation options.



Once in Boulder, turn west on Second Street at Hardware Hanks. Follow Free Enterprise Mine logo signs to top of hill, two miles from Main Street.

The population of Boulder is about 1300 people. Town businesses include motels, hot springs, diners, thrift store, taverns, library, museum, gas station, hardware store, medical clinic, pharmacy, bank, post office, historic courthouse, grocer, churches, parks, bowling alley and a swimming pool. Weather is mostly dry and moderate. Expect inclement weather at any time of the year.
